	<input type="checkbox"/>	Engine oil Check and top up.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Power steering fluid Check and top up.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Radiator coolant Check and top up.

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Brake fluid Check and top up.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Battery Inspect for leaks and make sure cables are connected
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Tyres Check air pressure and look out for signs of wear.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Dashboard lights Check to see if any fuses have blown.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Important lights: Check high and low beams.
